Joel Caldwell is requesting a one-year extension to the deadline for completion of improvements for lease Lot 3, Block 4, General Aviation Apron Subdivision No. 1, Plat 73-68. This would allow them until June 30, 2025 to make improvements. The current lease requires the lessee to construct additional storage space, restroom facilities, and paving by June 30,2024 with an aggregate cost of at least \$100,000.

With the departure of Ravn Air, Kenai Aviation had to scramble to fill the demand of flight services and redirect project funding in order to sustain and expand Kenai Aviation Flight services. As a result, the construction of the required improvements has been delayed. Their plan is to complete the work by May 2025 and they have been working with contractors to schedule the work.

The Airport Landscaping project is moving through the necessary steps to be completed this summer. The bids for this project closed on May 21<sup>st</sup>. Moore's Landscaping LLC was the successful bidder for the project and City Council approved the contract on June 5<sup>th</sup>. The cost of the landscaping work will be \$94,733. Earthscape LLC is now finished with their part as they did the design. The contract documents are now out for signatures. Once that is complete the next step will be to set the dates for the work.
