Hello Kenai! Alaska-born and a Kenai Central High grad, my wife and I are raising our family right here in the community we love. Whether you're a young parent, part of our working class, or a retiree, I understand what you need from your city council.

I personally drove to completion Memoranda of Understanding with both the Salamatof Native Association and the Kenaitze Indian Tribe, building lasting government-to-government relationships.
