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Survey Methodology

From January 6 - 26, 2026, Probolsky Research conducted an open access online survey among the City of Kenai residents. A total of 15 residents were surveyed. Interviews were conducted with online survey methods in English.

The sample was developed from an open link survey that was available through multiple outreach sources from the City of Kenai.

Probolsky Research is a Latina and woman owned market and opinion research firm with corporate, election, government, non-profit and special interest clients.
