Question: Can you provide us with your expected timeline to complete this scope of work? We see a scheduled start date of November 1, but don't know where to find the contract term period.

Response: The City does not have a defined time of performance for the scope of services at this time. March 1, 2022 has been discussed as a possible date to schedule a City Council Work Session to discuss the Kenai Waterfront Assessment and Feasibility Study, and this date was provided to the Kenai City Council at an August 4, 2021 Work Session on Kenai Waterfront Revitalization and Economic Development Incentives. However, it is anticipated that the successful proposer will engage City personnel to discuss the project, scope, project plan and timelines.
