01-01 Plan Holder Question –

“Will the city change the bid schedule for Type IIA and Type III to cubic yards? If not will the city allow for a surveyed per cubic yard pay item for Type IIA and Type III conversion? See Page C8 Detail A note 4.”

Response: The city will allow conversion to cubic yards under the following conditions: Payment shall remain by the Ton. However, the City will accept calculating the Tons based on a surveyed volume of material placed, completed by a Professional Land Surveyor licensed in the State of Alaska, multiplied by a unit weight of material. The surveyor shall provide a survey bottom of excavation and top of classified fill and compute a volume of material placed. The survey and calculations shall be submitted for the Owner's review and acceptance. The unit weight of the material shall be 95% of the maximum density as determined by AASHTO T 180.
