

**Public Notice for City of Kenai Water System
Public Water System (PWSID #240448)**

BOIL WATER NOTICE

**City of Kenai's water service connections located east of
Beaver Loop Road.**

The Department of Environmental Conservation's Drinking Water Program, in conjunction with the City of Kenai, has issued a boil water notice for all users of the City's public water system for locations east of Beaver Loop Road.

Due to a broken water main and a loss of pressure, the water system has an increased chance for microbiological contamination. Therefore, users of the water system in the locations noted above should boil all water used for potable purposes for at least two minutes prior to use.

This Boil Water Notice is being issued because of a broken water main, which has left a portion of the main line without water pressure. Loss of water pressure can result in back-siphonage and infiltration of contaminated water into the distribution lines. This increases the risk of bacteria or other microorganisms contaminating the water system. The City of Kenai will restore the water pressure, disinfect and flush the water lines and have the water tested for bacteria. This notice is to be posted in locations where the loss of pressure was experienced, and users of the water system in these locations should not use the water for any potable purposes until DEC and the City have announced that the water has been tested and determined to be safe to drink. When water has been restored to your facility, please flush all your water lines (hot and cold water) thoroughly.

This public health advisory is required by DEC and provided to you by the City of Kenai to help ensure that your health is protected.
