01-02 Plan Holder Question

(1) What are the specifications for final product? 100% passing 1/4" or 5/16" or are there any bottom end minimums?

- (2) Are we required to pay Davis Bacon wages?
- (3) I have a two deck power screening plant, with two 4'X5' decks. Will this be considered "an equal".

(4) The specs note "stockpiled" materials, are we feeding out of a bank or is there 6000 CY stockpiled?

Response: (1) See the attached Exhibit A. 100% passing the No 8 sieve and 0-2% passing the No 80 sieve. (2) Davis Bacon wages only apply to a government KMA Sand Screening

construction contract, this is not a construction contract. Davis Bacon wages do not apply. (3) As long as contractor can meet the gradation requirements without intermixing of materials, and compliance test results meet the requirements this would be acceptable to Owner. (4) Contractor will pull from the large stock pile created by the original excavation of the float plane basin. We estimate 30K-40K yds remain. The material is a relatively clean sand already, however contractor should expect some amount of organics, some silt, and smaller rocks mixed in. There is plenty of staging room in the area for the Contractors equipment.





#### 01-03 Plan Holder Question

Looking through the specifications for KMA sand screening contract and I'm not seeing attached exhibit A dictating which FAA gradation you are looking for. Please advise what gradation the city is requesting.

#### 01-04 Additional Requirement

Response: To ensure Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) compliance the Owner is requesting two test samples are taken during the Contractor's screening process. One at startup, within the first hundred yards, and one near completion, between 5,000-6,000 yds screened. The cost of this compliance testing shall be included in the contractor's bid. Taurianen Engineering, McLane's Consulting or other testing lab of Contractor's choice are acceptable. Sand is not usable by airport if it fails gradation requirements. Contractor accepts the responsibility of meeting gradation requirements if test sample results do not indicate compliance.

## 4.2 Controlling Snow Drifts.

The Airport does not utilize snow fences and/or trenches. Snow drifts are basically pushed way back behind the lights with loaders.

#### 4.3 Snow Disposal.

Snow dump areas are designated on Snow Removal Plan Exhibit 139.313A.

# 4.4 Methods for Ice Control and Removal–Chemicals.

The Airport uses prilled urea and E36 (potassium acetate). The E36 is injected into the sand and applied during freezing rain conditions. Both the urea and wet sand is spread with a mechanical sander.

# 4.5 Sand (for the purposes of treating a winter surface).

Dry sand is basically applied anytime braking action deteriorates or conditions demand.
